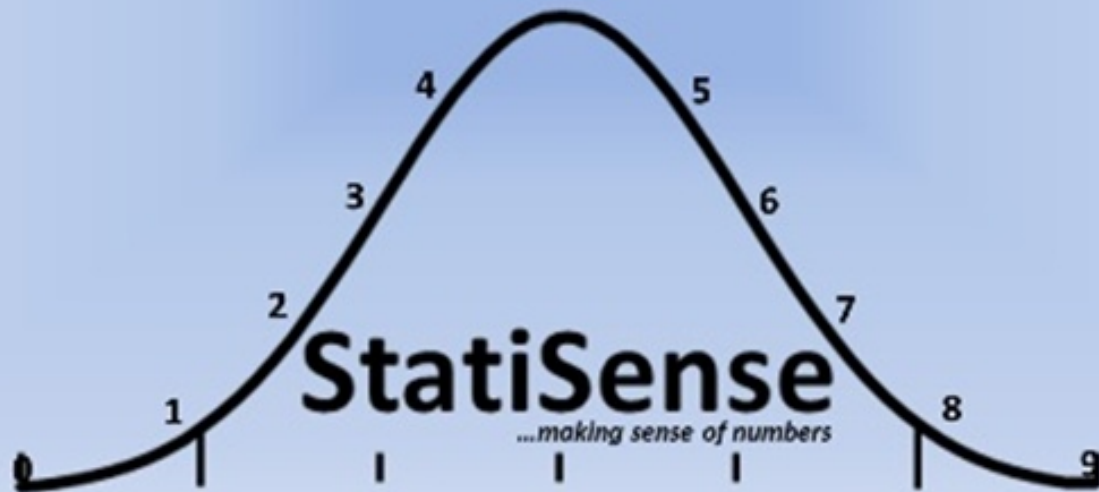

- In September 2015, the UN General Assembly adopted a new development agenda for the period 2016–2030 that includes a set of sustainable development goals (SDGs)
- There are 17 **SDGs** with **169** associated targets that are supported by three pillars of sustainability:
 1. Economic development
 2. Environmental protection
 3. Social equity

Status Report

The First meeting on Sustainable Development Goals-2030 was held on 08.07.2016.

First meeting on preparation of Vision 2030 document was held on 26.09.2016 under the chairmanship of the Chief Secretary.

Second Meeting was held on 26.10.2016 under the chairmanship of the Finance Secretary to review the progress in preparation of draft document .

The Third Review meeting on preparation of Vision 2030 document was held on 18.11.2016.

The preparation on Strategy Paper on Resource Efficiency and Circular Economy has been assigned to TERI on 21.09.2018. The First meeting review is scheduled to be held on 06.12.2018



Fourth Review meeting was held on 27.11.2018 under the chairmanship of the Chief Secretary.

The Chief Secretary directed the Nodal Departments to quantify the Physical Targets to be achieved and to monitor the same.

Status Report

- Goa Institute of Public Administration and Rural Development (GIPARD) has organized two days writeshop at International Centre Goa on 21-22nd April 2017.
- GIPARD is in the process of preparing “Guide to prepare road map for implementation of six Sustainable Development Goals” for the state of Goa.
- GIPARD is in the process of Finalizing the road map for six sustainable Development Goals for the state of Goa.

Status Report

- Government has constituted a core committee vide its notification dated 09.11.2017 to monitor smooth implementation & progress of SDGs and targets.
- Government has appointed Nodal Officers and Nodal departments against each SDG its notification dated 09.11.2017 to monitor smooth implementation & progress of SDGs and targets in the State.
- NITI Aayog has organized workshops on SDGs for the concerned Nodal departments implementing SDGs.
