- The state has 22 districts, 320 blocks, 4198 panchayats spread over a total of 6337 inhabited villages.

- √ The State is in the process of framing Action Plan on SDG for J&K State. The main problem faced in the formulation of SDG Action Plan are:
- 1) The Local Body elections in J&K State had not been conducted during past three years which have now been conducted and completed for Municipal Corporations/Municipal Committees of the state. Similarly, panchayat elections had also not

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which are currently going on in phases. The process of election is likely to be completed, within a fortnight

- 2) The staff identified and designated for implementation of SDG are lacking capacity and knowledge to carry forward the revised formats presented in SDG.
- 3) The task of mapping of resources to align with major SDG goals has been found difficult as the size of state plan/Capex Budget is not adequate and is merely allocated to provide matching share for CSS.

- Please provide an update on any dedicated unit/cell /centre/team on SDGs operating at the State/UT level: -
- √ The state of J&K has constituted an Apex Level Committee headed by Chief Secretary to oversee and monitor progress in the implementation of SDG in the state. A copy of Govt order will be handed over to NITI Aayog.
- ✓ A dedicated Nodal unit has been constituted by the Govt in the Directorate of Economics & Statistics. A copy of Govt order will be handed over to NITI Aayog.

- ✓ A well-qualified SDG cell has been constituted in the Directorate of Economics & Statistics for collection of reliable baseline data, its compilation and preparation of Action Plan for SDG in the state. A copy of order is being handed over to NITI Aayog.
- √ Three officers of J&K State have been deputed to National Statistical Systems Training Academy (NSSTA), Noida to obtain necessary training for implementation of SDG in the state.

- √ The district level committees to be headed by District Development Commissioners are being constituted in the state.
- √ Two monitoring units are being constituted at the level of two Directorate of Urban Local Body to coordinate SDG implementation in Municipalities/Town Area Committees.

- √ Two monitoring committees are being constituted in two Municipal Corporations of the state.
- ✓ At block level, committees are being constituted to coordinate implementation of SDG at panchayat level.
