# Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs)

Karnataka aims to have effective and efficient action plan for achieving all the 17 Goals through discussion led by experts, the concerned departments and other stakeholders.

# SDG Framework of Karnataka



## State Level Steering Committee

State Level Steering Committee as the Apex committee for taking policy decisions relating to the preparation of State Action Plan for achieving SDGs by 2030 which will be prepared by 17 Goal Committees.



## Nodal Officer

Nodal officers have been appointed from each department concerned with the SDGs for effective implementation of the Action Plans.



## Monitoring and Co-ordination Committee

The committee to monitor and coordinate the overall project implementation including preparation of State Action Plan, and all the SDGs related activities under the project.



## Goal Committee

17 goal Committees to enable integrating Sustainable Development Goals into the State planning and functioning. The committee will prepare the medium-term(2022) and long-term (2030) goals for seven years and fifteen years, respectively.



# Activity Plan of the State

1

1. Technical Cell on SDGs.
2. Appointment of Nodal Officers in each département
3. Formation of State SDGs Committees (State Level Steering Committee, Monitoring and Coordination Committee, Goals Committees )

1. Finalizing Karnataka's Framework for mapping nodal and concerned departments and the existing state programmes and policies with SDG targets.
2. Finalizing Karnataka's Action Plan for achieving SDGs by 2030.
3. Integrating with Annual Budget.

1. Development of training modules on SDGs.
2. Sensitization workshops with district, taluk and gram panchayat level elected representatives.

3. Integration of SDGs into GPDPs.

5

1. Posters and other IEC material on SDGs with information on the goals, targets, indicators, corresponding schemes and the progress of Karnataka.



## Status as on 30.11.2018 (1)

- SDG Cell has been formed in the Planning Department of Karnataka to provide technical support for the attainment of SDGs.
- MoU has been signed with National Foundation for India to provide guidance and support in preparation of the action plan and strategies for effective implementation of SDGs in the State.
- Departments have been identified for each of the targets and indicators.

## Status as on 30.11.2018 (contd.)

- Nodal officers from each of the related departments of SDGs has been appointed to ensure effective and efficient implementation of SDGs.
- Karnataka has formed Monitoring and Coordinating Committee and the State Level Steering Committee for smooth functioning, implementation and monitoring of SDGs till 2030.
- Goal Committees have been having regular meetings for consultation on the preparation of State action plan for each goal.
- Indicators are almost finalized for all the goals and draft action plans for all the goals will be prepared by December, 2018.

## Status as on 30.11.2018 (contd.)

- Data management of department wise information collected through DSS for monthly KDP review of physical and financial progress under the Chairmanship of the Chief Secretary will enable using authentic and periodic data.
- **Developing, facilitating, sensitizing and capacity building training programs for providing exposure and orientation to officials and stakeholders.**
- **Developing IEC materials to optimally implement SDGs.**
