## Dr K. Rajeswara Rao, Special Secretary

Dr K. Rajeswara Rao is currently Special Secretary, NITI Aayog. He leads the Urban Development (Managing Urbanization) and Urban Poverty Alleviation, Skill Development, Labour and Employment Verticals, among others.
