



1. The Third Eye of Governance/N Bhaskara Rao








4. A Man with Mission Narendra Modi/Kumar Pankaj


5. Accelerating India 7 year of Modi Government/K J Alphons


6. Modi Again: Why Modi is Right for India/Aabhas Maldahiyar

7. From Chanakya to Modi : The Evolution of India's foreign Policy/ Aparna Pande








9. Modi's Economics/ Rajeshkumar Acharya

10. Marching with a Billion/ Uday Mahurkar




