1.2	Power and duties of its officers and employees [Section 4(1) (b)(ii)]	<p>The Data Management and Analysis Division primarily deals with issues relating to streamlining data usage for public policy. One of its key initiatives is the National Data and Analytics Platform (NDAP) which aims to democratize access to public government data by making data accessible, interoperable, interactive, and available on a user- friendly platform. It hosts datasets from various government agencies, presents them coherently, and provides tools for analytics and visualization. The core functions broadly cover:</p> <p>Data management and integration on NDAP including development of data collection strategies and coordination with Ministries; monitoring Key Performance Indicators (KPIs) of NDAP; product strategy and roadmap for furthering the evolution of NDAP.</p> <p>Formulation of policy papers and strategy documents in collaboration with experts from the Government, academia and industry, and conducting seminars and workshops on data management and use in policy making.</p> <p>Document issues related to data management and usage, and leverage technology for improved statistical systems and processes.</p> <p>Function as the Secretariat for Women Entrepreneurship Platform, an initiative taken by NITI Aayog in 2018 to address information asymmetry towards building a robust women entrepreneurial ecosystem. In 2022 WEP transitioned to a public private partnership model.</p> <p>Coordinate and liaison with the National Statistical Commission (NSC) on statistical surveys and data ecosystem as CEO, NITI Aayog is an ex-officio member of NSC.</p> <p>. The files are initiated at the level of Research Assistant and submitted through Under Secretary/Deputy Secretary or Director for the final decision at the level of Programme Director/CEO, NITI Aayog.</p>
