1.3.1	Process of decision making Identify key decision-making points	AIM follows extant process of decision making of Govt. of India, as applicable.
1.3.2	Final decision-making authority	Final decision making authority varies from case to case and includes authority upto the level of the MD (AIM)/CEO as the case may be.
1.3.3	Related provisions, acts, rules etc.	Extant Govt. of India provisions, acts, rules etc. are followed and other rules/provisions issued by the competent authority
1.3.4	Time limit for taking a decisions, if any	Cases are disposed of within the minimum possible time depending upon the level of disposal of a particular case.
1.3.5	Channel of supervision and accountability	Actions are taken in accordance with the departmental instructions prescribing the level of final disposal and channel of submission for each category of cases.
